KEVIN CHURCHWELL, MD

President & CEO Boston Children's Hospital Kevin B. Churchwell, MD, is the President and Chief Executive Officer of Boston Children's Hospital, providing leadership, and oversight for a team that's dedicated to advancing child health through life-changing work in clinical care, research, medical education, and community engagement.

Since joining Boston Children's as Executive Vice President of Health Affairs and Chief Operating Officer in 2013, Dr. Churchwell has brought to BCH the same passion for enhancing patient/employee safety, and the patient family experience that defined his tenure as CEO of both Nemours/Alfred I. duPont Hospital for Children and Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital, part of the Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville, TN.

DANA SUSKIND, MD

Professor, University of Chicago Founder & Co-Director of TMW Center Dr. Dana Suskind is a Professor of Surgery, Pediatrics and Public Policy (affiliated) at the University of Chicago and Co-Director of the TMW Center for Early Learning + Public Health. An internationally recognized thought leader, Dr. Suskind has dedicated her research and clinical life to optimizing foundational brain development and preventing early cognitive disparities and their lifelong impact. In 2013, Dana and her team led the first-ever Bridging the Thirty Million Word Gap convening at the request of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy. She is the author of "Thirty Million Words: Building a Child's Brain" and the New York Times bestselling book, "Parent Nation: Unlocking Every Child's Potential, Fulfilling Society's Promise", which empowers parents to use developmental neuroscience to build a society that works for families, not against them.



GEETA LAL, MD

Professor of Surgery & Pediatrics University of Iowa Geeta Lal, MD MSc FRCS(C) FACS is a Professor of Surgery and Pediatrics in the Division of Surgical Oncology and Endocrine Surgery at the University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine.

Dr. Lal received her BS from McMaster University, and her MD at the University of Toronto. She earned an MSc at the University of Toronto and The Samuel Lunenfeld Research Institute. She completed residency in General Surgery at the University of Toronto and a fellowship in Endocrine Surgical Oncology at the University of California, San Francisco. Dr. Lal has served in many different roles throughout her career, including being the Co-Leader of the cancer center's Endocrine Multidisciplinary Oncology Group and heading an NIH-funded basic science laboratory for many years. She was the Associate Chief Quality Officer for the Adult Inpatient Services at her institution till July 2022 and continues to maintain a busy endocrine surgery practice.

Having experienced work-related musculoskeletal symptoms herself, she is committed to increasing awareness of and developing solutions to counteract the impact of poor ergonomics on surgeons' professional and personal lives. She is the founder of Surgical Ergonomics, a speaking and coaching business and a co-founder and Inaugural President of the new Society of Surgical Ergonomics.
